### Access by Train

#### 1) Gare du Nord

Trains from Belgium, Germany, the Netherlands, and the United Kingdom, and Scandinavia.

The station is situated in the northern part of Paris (see map). The metro station Gare du Nord is serviced by Line 4 running Porte de Clignancourt – Mairie de Montrouge, Line 5 between Bobigny – Pablo Picasso and Place d'Italie, Commuter trains RER B and D is servicing the station.

#### 2) Gare de l'Est

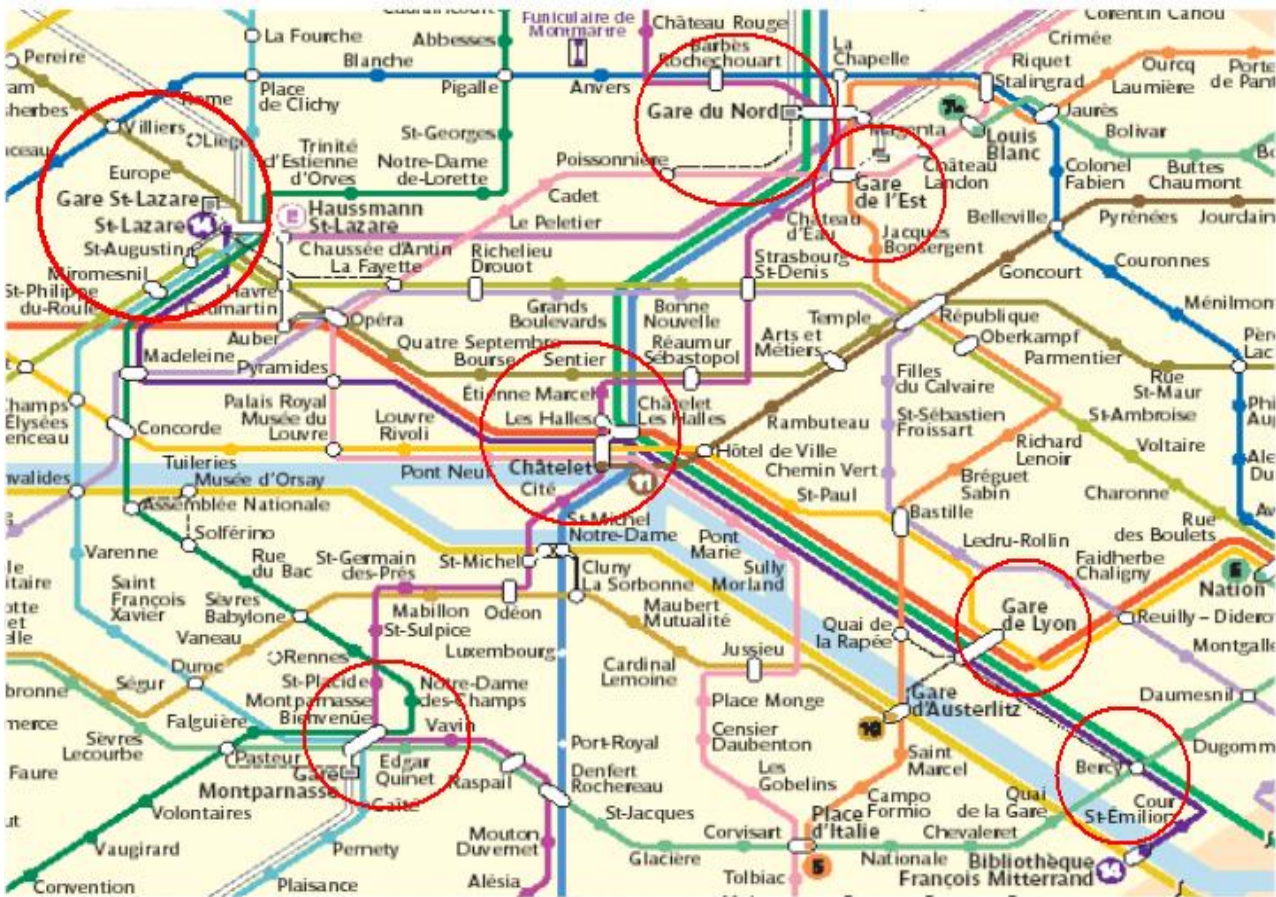
Trains from Germany, Poland, Luxembourg.

The station is situated in the northern part of Paris (see map). The metro station Gare de l'Est is serviced by Line 4 running Porte de Clignancourt – Mairie de Montrouge, Line 5 between Bobigny Pablo Picasso and Place d'Italie. Line 7 with directions La Courneuve 8 Mai 1945 and Villejuif Louis Aragon/Mairie d'Ivry. Also commuter train RER E is servicing the station.

#### 3) Gare de Lyon

Trains from Switzerland and Spain.

The station is situated in the eastern part of Paris (see map). The metro station Gare du Lyon is serviced by Line 1 directions La Défense and Château de Vincennes, Line 14 between Saint-Lazare And Olympiades. The commuter trains RER A and D is servicing the station.



### Access by Air flight

#### 4) Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) also known as Roissy Airport

This is one of the world's principal aviation centres, as well as France's largest airport.

Instructions on getting to Paris from Roissy CDG:

By Train:

- Take line: RER B (Blue) in the direction of Paris (Robinson, Antony, St-Rémy-les-Chevreuse).
  - The train stops at all stations in Paris: Gare du Nord, Châtelet-les Halles, St Michel/Nôtre Dame, Luxembourg, Port Royal, Denfert - Rochereau, Cité Universitaire.
  - To change trains from RER B for the subway (Metro lines). The closest metro lines are: line 6 (Cambronne or Sèvres Lecourbe), line 10 (Séгур) and line 12 (Volontaires).
- Cost: 10 Euros (adult fare)

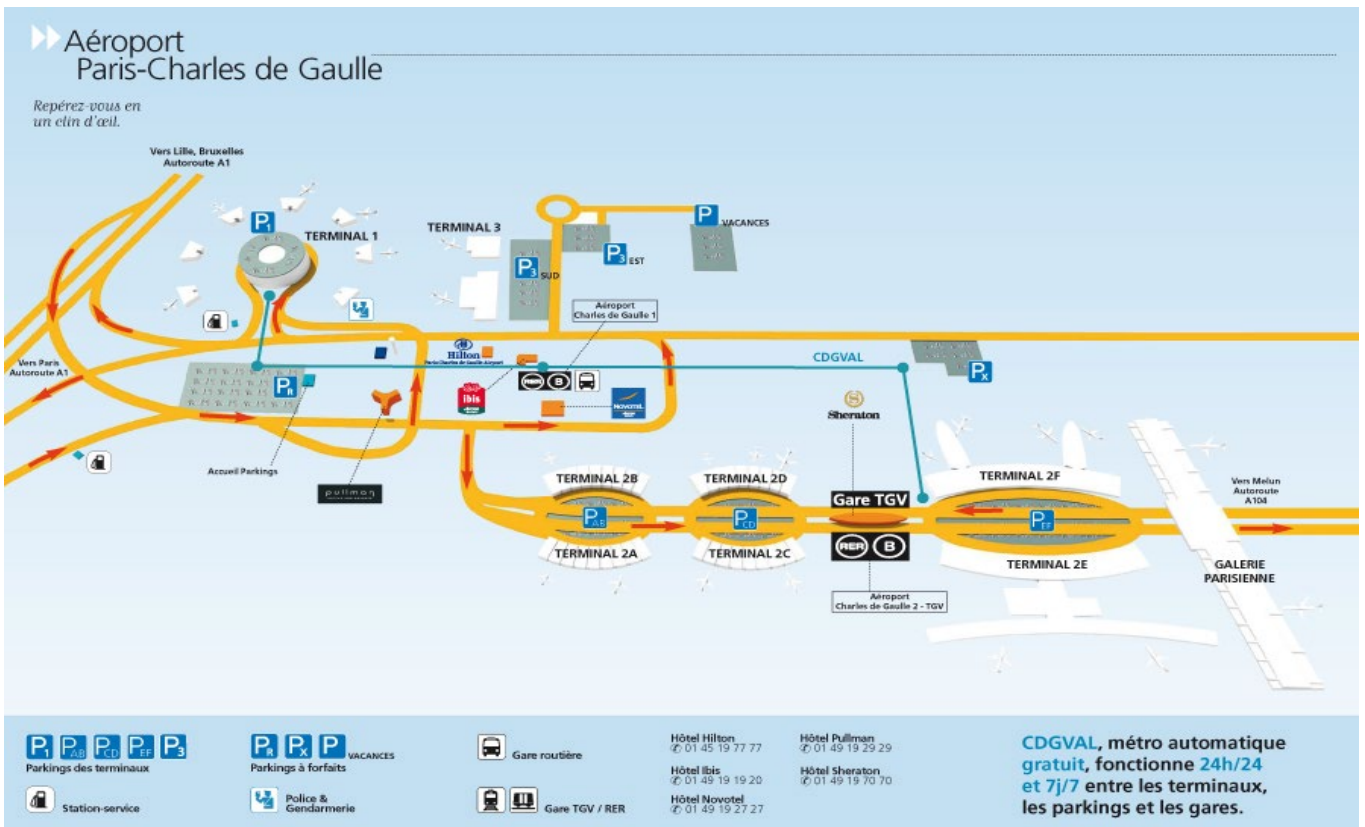


- Timetable: Between 04:56 and 23:50

By Bus:

- **RoissyBus** connects Roissy CDG with Paris (Opéra)
  - Cost: 11 Euros
  - Departure: Terminals 1, 2 and 3
  - Arrival: Opéra (Corner of rue Scribe and rue Auber)
- **LeBusDirect** (<https://www.lebusdirect.com/en/>) connects:
  - Roissy CDG with Paris Eiffel Tower **LIGNE 2**
    - Cost: 17 Euros
  - Roissy CDG with Paris Gare Montparnasse **LIGNE 4**
    - Cost: 17 Euros
  - Timetable: Between 6:00 to 22:00

5) Paris Orly International Airport (ORY)



## Instructions on getting to Paris from ORY:

### By Train:

- Take line: **OrlyVal + RER B** (Blue) Direction
  - OrlyVal: to Antony RER B station
  - Change trains at Antony and take RER B towards Paris (Direction Mitry – Claye, Airport Charles de Gaulle)
  - Timetable: Between 06:00 and 23:00
  - Cost: 12,05 Euros

### By Bus:

- **OrlyBus** that connects ORY with Paris (Place Denfert - Rochereau)
  - Cost: 7,7 Euros
  - Departure: Orly - Sud porte C and Orly - Ouest port D Arrival level
  - Arrival: Place Denfert – Rochereau
- **LeBusDirect** (<https://www.lebusdirect.com/en/>) connects:
  - Orly airport with Paris Etoile/Champs-Elysees **LIGNE 1**
  - Cost: 12 Euros
  - Timetable: Between 6:30 to 22:30





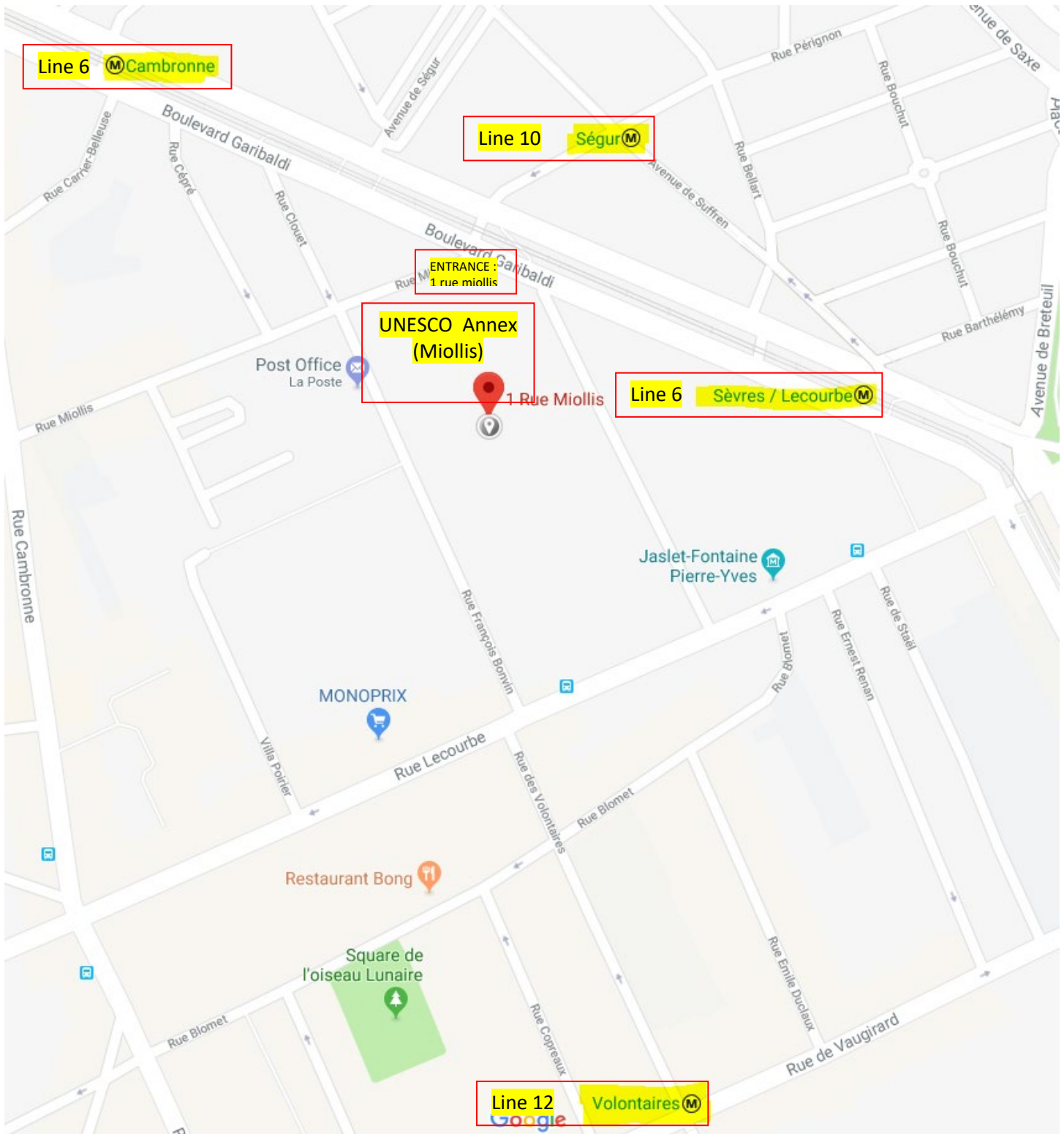


### UN environment office location:

UN Environment is located in the 15<sup>th</sup> area of Paris and is well connected to the rest of the city.

Closest Metro stations are:

- Cambronne (Metro line 6)
- Sevres - Lecourbe (Metro line 6)
- Segur (Metro line 10)
- Volontaires (Metro line 12)





## How to get to UN Environment (UNESCO – Miollis Building) premises from the train stations and the airports

The closest metro is Cambronne.

- From Gare du Nord, take RER B from Gare du Nord to Denfert-Rochereau, change to Line 6 and get off at Cambronne
- From Gare de l'Est, take Line 4 from Gare de l'Est to Odéon, change to Line 10 and get off at Segur
- From Gare de Lyon, take Line 14 to Bercy, change to Line 6 and get off at Cambronne
- To get to Cambronne from **Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport** take RER B, get off at Denfert - Rochereau station and change to Metro line 6 to Cambronne station.
- If you are taking RoissyBus, at the final destination of the bus, Paris Opera, get Metro line 8 and get off at La Motte – Picquet-Grenelle stop. Then change to Metro line 6 and get off at Cambronne.
- To get to Cambronne from **Paris Orly International Airport** take RER B from Antony station to Denfert - Rochereau station and change to Metro line 6 to Cambronne station.
- If you are taking OrlyBus, from Denfert-Rochereau station, take Metro line 6 to Cambronne station.
- If you are using the BusDirect, from:
  - Champs Elysées, take Metro line 13 Champs Elysées Clemenceau station up to Montparnasse Bienvenüe station, then change to Metro line 6 to Cambronne station.
  - Paris Eiffel Tower, take Metro line 6 - Bir-Hakeim station to Cambronne station.
  - Paris Gare Montparnasse, take Metro line 6 to Cambronne station.
- From Roissy CDG and Orly airports, you can also change trains at RER B, Saint Michel/Nôtre Dame station and take Metro line 10 to Segur station.
